Adult Clinical Interventions 2 continues investigating intervention techniques for adults by critically evaluating the empirical research literature pertaining to a variety of clinical interventions. Students will demonstrate a working knowledge of a variety of empirically validated interventions, an ability to select appropriate psychological techniques and knowledge of how to apply a variety of clinical interventions. Students will evaluate, in the context of day to day clinical practice, the effectiveness of a variety of interventions used in the treatment of adult psychological problems.
